

RULES FOR IN PERSON WORSHIP IN THE CHURCH

You must adhere to the following:

- If you are feeling unwell, have a temperature, or have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID, please stay home.
- Wear a mask, use hand sanitizer (there are four new touchless hand sanitizer stations in the church), maintain social distancing.
- If you take a bulletin, you are responsible for its disposal. It cannot be left in the church.
- Follow the patterns for movement – i.e., follow the taped arrows telling you the direction you must move. This is not negotiable.
- Be seated in the appropriate areas that have been created for families, couples, singles.
- When standing in line to receive communion, you must maintain a distance of six feet. Areas will be marked with tape; please adhere.
- Do not remove your mask. After the wafer has been put into your hand, walk away, slip it in under your mask.
- The bathrooms will not be open.
- Everyone must sign in for contact tracing.
- Do not touch anything in the church other than the pew in which you are seated. This includes paper handouts, unless you intend to take it with you.
