Make an ethnic craft and sell it at the Cultural Bazaar. Maker of the most popular craft will be crowned the “2020 Cultural Arts & Crafts Queen or King”!
- ETHNIC FOODS  
Share bite size samples of your favorite ethnic snacks, meals or desserts.
