Commitment:

Absences are discouraged and can result in being dropped from the course.

The tuition commitment is \$400 and is non-refundable after September 9, 2016. Payment is accepted from individual participants or from the individual's employer. An invoice will be sent on request. Tuition covers all meals, materials, supplies and most transportation for the VALU classes. Participants may be asked to provide some personal transportation as well.
