Join us for a lecture and discussion about the impact of cell phone use on our brains. Dr. Kimberly Bussey will teach us about the history of technology and how we have gotten to this point where we are so dependent on our cell phones. Even though Dr. Bussey is a member of Generation X, computers have always been a part of her life – she can’t remember a time when there wasn’t a modem and at least a terminal in the house. Those tools gave her an early exposure to technology, and in particular, social interaction in cyberspace. They also impressed upon her the need to keep the technology a tool and not an experience. Dr. Bussey is interested in how user interfaces interact with the wiring of our brains and how we can use that information to create habits to prevent technology from becoming our primary experience.

Kimberly (Kim) Bussey, PhD, Faculty Associate, School of Mathematical and Natural Sciences, and Adjunct Faculty, BEYOND Center, ASU; Managing Partner, Equinox Technologies LLC – Dr. Bussey is a geneticist, cancer researcher, and computation biologist developing tools to help oncologists utilize genomics in clinical practice. She co-directs *Interface: Faith and Science* at Pinnacle Presbyterian Church through the Fran Park Center for Faith and Life. Dr. Bussey is also the parent of two teenagers who actively involved in the Pinnacle Music Ministries and second-generation computer programmer.
