Dear Fellow Flight Attendants –

The Acting MEC President Chasity Theno is hosting and will chair a Special Meeting to elect the MEC President and MEC Vice President. The meeting will be tomorrow, Wednesday, May 25, 2022 at 900 am/HST. The MEC is requiring that you pre-register. If you are planning on attending the meeting, please register [by clicking here!](#)

With respect to the MEC Elections, our priority is serving the Membership. We believe that it is critical that we have MEC Officers who serve all Members while adhering to the [AFA-CWA Constitution & Bylaws](#). There needs to be a clear understanding for our [Collective Bargaining Agreement](#) (a.k.a. Contract) while ensuring that the processes available to us are effected. This term will commence on May 25, 2022 and end June 30, 2023.

Our structure outlines how the MEC Officers carry out the work set forth by the MEC – voting Members (Council 43 LEC President and Council 47 LEC President). With one of the largest councils in the AFA-CWA system, we have a responsibility not just to our Members, but our siblings in Los Angeles and throughout our broader Flight Attendant network.

The Council 43 nomination and vote will be for the best qualified candidate for each position. We will rely on the AFA-CWA Constitution & Bylaws as the basis for our vote. Additionally, our nominee must:

- 1) have a clear understanding of the AFA-CWA structure and responsibilities;
- 2) collaborate with both councils/bases and represent all Members;
- 3) have a solid understanding of the Contract, value Contract Education and respect the history and intent of our Contract; and
- 4) have the ability to be present and engaged while communicating with the AFA leadership, Members, other labor groups and the Company in a professional, clear and timely manner.

We'd like to thank all candidates who have expressed interest in these positions. This is never an easy decision and we appreciate anyone who makes themselves available to serve the Membership. While we can only elect only one person for each position, there are always opportunities to volunteer and assist the Membership. We will welcome all candidates to assist in any capacity.
