US House of Representatives Hawaii District 2

The AFA-CWA endorses many candidates running in a national election on a non-partisan basis. The LEC and MEC officers are not in any way involved in this endorsement process. Any candidate running for a Congress or Senate seat who asks for an endorsement from the AFA-CWA must go through a vetting process following all national election laws, the AFA-CWA Political Legislative Policy Committee and through the AFA-CWA Legal Department. Candidates are required to fill out a questionnaire on their stance on AFA-CWA issues. As the vetting process is completed, the AFA-CWA will make an official announcement, joining HAL ALPA, CWA locals, Senator Brian Schatz, Senator Mazie Hirono, Congressman Ed Case and others in the support of Kai Kahele for US House of Representatives, Hawaii District 2.

Please make sure you are registered to VOTE and remember to VOTE. It's not about who you vote for, it's that you do VOTE.
