AFA-CWA FlightPAC was established in 1982 to maintain our influence in the legislative arena; it is essential to support political programs which complement our legislative activity. FlightPAC, part of CWA's Political Action Fund complies with campaign finance laws and our union dues are never contributed to any campaigns.

FlightPAC/PAF (political actions fund) contributions are voluntary and not tax deductible. Provides financial support to federal candidates in office who commit to helping AFA accomplish our goals.

FlightPAC IS NON-PARTISAN: We give to candidates who help flight attendants. I know we don't all have the same political/social beliefs. The fact remains that there are issues that affect all members. Most recently and importantly the bipartisan support for the PSP.
