SCR Grievance, Update

Dear Fellow Flight Attendants,

After reviewing this week's Scheduling Clarification Review (SCR) forms, the following reminders may help you:

**FLIGHT RELEASE PROGRAM, CBA Section 17.Q**

In working with our MEC Negotiating Committee Chair Ka`imi Lee, we discussed the history of Flight Release on property. Ka`imi provided great insight to help us understand the program and its history. For more information please [click here!](#)

Here are some important Flight Release Program points to keep in mind:

1. There is no pay and credit for the released days.
2. Reserves minimum monthly guarantee is reduced by 2.83 hours for each day only if the reserve has not flown 72 hours in that month.
3. Flight Attendants granted release are not eligible for the perfect attendance bonus vacation day in that quarter.
4. There is no impact on longevity.

**FLICA APP, REMINDER, CBA Section 11.F**

We have seen a few inquiries with respect to using the Flight View app that you can purchase for your mobile devices. Although the Company works on the schedule through the course of the preceding day, it is not official until published. Therefore, you may believe that you have a trip that was assigned in the morning, but it is not your trip/assignment until published at the contractual time. Please ensure that you understand and sign-off on your trip after 1700 HST.

**INTER-ISLAND AIRCRAFT UPGAUGE CHECK-IN TIMES, CBA Section 34-13.E**

We have seen several inquiries where the Company has upgauged an inter-island flight. As a result, your original check-in time may have changed due to the larger aircraft. While it is crew scheduling's responsibility to notify you, there have been several instances when some of the Flight Attendants have not been called in advance. Please note that you should not be disciplined for this lapse.
