Dear Flight Attendants,

Quarantining Away From Domicile – COVID Exposures

In recent weeks, we have been experiencing an increase of COVID exposures that are forcing crew members to quarantine, for up to 10 days, unexpectedly away from domicile, on the mainland and on the neighbor islands. These guidelines are in accordance with FAA (SAFO) and CDC recommendations.

Please keep in mind when leaving for work, wherever you may be flying, that you are prepared in the event this happens. For example, packing extra clothing, medications, personal need items and money or a credit card, even on neighbor island trips, is essential and a friendly reminder to include as part of your “regular” trip preparations.

As safety professionals we need to be even more prepared in these uncertain times. As always, your AFA Officers or AFA EAP representatives are available should you need assistance while away.

Vaccination Support Program Compensation

If you uploaded your proof of vaccination in the month of July, you should have received compensation in the August 20 pay period in one of the following ways:

- Sick Time – Sick hours taken within the 48-hour period following each vaccination dose will be credited back to your sick bank on 8/20.
- Pay – If no sick time was taken during the 48-hour period following either dose, you will receive pay equivalent to one vacation day. This will be paid at your current rate of pay as of the date of payment. Reflected as “Cares 2.0 Pay” on your pay statement.
- The deadline for submission is November 1 for all employees.
