re: Los Angeles Airport, Terminal Change

Dear Fellow Flight Attendants:

As some of you may have heard, the Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) terminal change for Hawaiian Airlines has finally come to fruition. After multiple date changes, today is the first day when our crews and passengers will need to transit through the Tom Bradley International Terminal rather than Terminal 5. [The company refers to the acronym TBIT.]

This is a huge adjustment for our Flight Attendants especially since the nearest Known Crewmember (KCM) line is in terminal 4. Although the company has been putting our information on the IFS Sharepoint website and also briefing crews, some of our members are not getting the necessary information.

According to our first crews going through KCM and then getting to TBIT, it took approximately 15 minutes. The crew pick-up as well as drop-off has changed so please be aware of this update.
