**Presidential Executive Order – Vaccination Plan Timeline**

On October 1, the company communicated the impact the Presidential Executive Order mandating vaccinations will have on the vaccination plan for all Hawaiian Airlines employees. Hawaiian is both a Federal Contractor and an employer with more than 100 employees.

Why is this significant? Because the Federal Employee/Contractor Order does not allow weekly testing as an alternative to the vaccine. That means that once the Transition Period Testing Program ends all Hawaiian employees will be required to be vaccinated against COVID-19. With the exception for employees who cannot be vaccinated due to a qualified medical disability or deeply held religious belief may request a reasonable accommodation.

While AFA believes vaccination is our best defense against illness or death from COVID-19, we fully recognize that some of our members have very strong concerns or beliefs regarding the COVID-19 vaccination. Being vaccinated is not open to negotiation with management – we cannot negotiate around it or grieve it. However, we will ensure the company abides by the Executive Orders and the applicable reasonable accommodation provisions.
