TRIP BROKERING REMINDER

In April 2019, a communication to the membership was posted regarding the seniority-violating "trip brokering" which circumvents seniority rights and gives trips or holidays off to those who could not hold them or to enrich certain Flight Attendants. This issue has been brought up again recently and we are once more posting another reminder to STOP the trip brokering and seniority violations, because every transaction conducted on Company software is logged and you put yourself at risk of being disciplined if caught.

Due to the high temperatures in LAS & to avoid Engine Gas Temperature (EGT) exceedance on our A321s, flight 31 has been capped at 16 first class pax & 155 economy class pax. Non-rev travelers will not see change in ID90 & the app may show more seats than available. In August, cap is expected to rise slightly to 16/159.
