HI CREW EXEMPTION and COMPANY POLICY

This makes it entirely too difficult to answer questions for each Flight Attendant. The recommended route is to reach out to the company's designated coordinator to help answer questions. You can also ask your questions directly of the UI department in the state that you are filing. As a friendly reminder, the AFA is not authorized to speak to the policies and practices of the UI office. This is outside of our purview and we appreciate your understanding.
