HAPPY NEW YEAR! I hope everyone had a fantastic Christmas and New Year Holiday, and you kept every service member who was not home with their loved ones in your thoughts and prayers. Volunteers are the backbone of our programs and serve a vital role in our organization, ensuring the success of our programs. Let's kick off this year by "Promoting Volunteering with Passion". So, what exactly does this mean? It means



getting involved in "Your" Lodge's activities, be it community service, volunteering whenever you can, recruiting new members, reaching out to members in arrears and asking them to come back. They joined for one reason or another, let's see if we can rekindle that fire and bring them back on board.

This month I wanted to share information about the Appointed Officers. The appointed officers include the Chaplain, Esquire, Inner Guard, and Tiler. Each of these positions has a very important role. The Chaplain leads the prayers for the opening, closing, and initiatory rituals. The Chaplain may also provide an invocation and benediction at any of our events. The Chaplain sets the tone for our meetings and events. The role of Esquire is to ensure the Lodge is organized for meetings, prepping the candidates for initiation, examining, and introducing visiting members, overseeing the balloting process, and delivering messages during meetings. As you can see, this is a significant role in our organization. The Inner Guard is responsible for guarding the inner door of the Lodge and admitting only

those that have followed the process to enter. This is an important part of the initiation ritual. Our Tiler role oversees guarding the outer door of the Lodge.



For those members who haven't attended an initiation meeting since becoming a member, I urge you to attend the meeting on January 16. No person can remember what was said by the officers in charge while being initiated, because you are too worried you are not going to do something right. You will find a new appreciation in our order when you can listen and digest the words the officers say during the ceremony.

Next month (February) we have nominations and election of our officers for the 2024/2025. Every chair officer, secretary, treasurer, and five-year trustee is nominated and elected by the general membership. Any Lodge member in good standing may nominate and vote. Much like voting in government elections, your vote counts!


