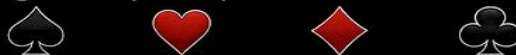

experience great need, and at a minimum they donate gift cards to area students in December to be used to purchase holiday gifts and food items. They also sponsor students to attend the YMCA Summer Camp Program, provide clothing, hygiene products, new shoes, and school supplies to local students, and fund annual Scholarships to selected Lemon Bay High School Students. A \$1,000 donation was made to this organization. Thank you, Cindy Bennett, for your time and efforts in arranging this engagement.
