Dear Park Families,

It is hard to believe that I am beginning my third year as Principal!. Watching your children grow and learn is the best part of my job. Staff and families do an amazing job engaging our children in academics and the arts and are making an impact on all of our futures. I am inspiring to hear what each child dreams to be and to witness the important roles we all play in helping them achieve them.

As a reminder, students may come into the building through the gym doors, accessed from the playground, at 7:30 A.M. to eat free breakfast. Supervision starts at 7:30 A.M. so please do not bring your child earlier.

A warning bell will ring at 8:00 A.M. for students to enter the building and get ready for class. The bell rings again at 8:10 A.M. to start the school day. Any student who arrives after 8:05 A.M. should enter through the front doors. A student who arrives after 8:10 A.M. will be considered tardy and an arrival after 8:30 A.M will be marked absent for half a day.

Student will be dismissed at 3:05 P.M. If your child is being picked up, please arrange with teachers what door your child will exit from. Additionally, parking in the parking lot at the start or end of the day is prohibited for safety reasons. Busses use the parking lot and students are not easily seen.

Please make sure that your child goes home in the method provided to the school. If there is a change and if possible, please send a note of the change in plans. Calls at the end of the day are difficult to ensure your child gets the message as there are many students.
