Hello MHS Parents and Guardians,

As most of you know, Governor Tony Evers has directed the state Department of Health Services to extend the state's safer-at-home order for several more weeks. The order, which was set to expire on April 24 will now end at 8 a.m. Tuesday, May 26. The order also states all public and private K-12 schools will remain closed for the rest of the school year, which ends June 30.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of the alternative plans we have made for our seniors during the month of May due to this new extended order. We made the difficult decision to cancel our traditional events and replace them with virtual programs. We realize nothing can compare to the real experience, but we believe we can still make this a special month for our seniors.
