

SENIOR YEARBOOK PHOTO SUBMISSION INFORMATION

Due Dates:

- **Remember When/Reenactments** - Oct. 14th
- **Senior Pics** - October 30th
- **Senior Quotes** - October 30th
 - Can't be longer than a 2016 tweet - 140 characters
 - If your quote is deemed inappropriate in ANY WAY your quote will be changed to "Go Marines!" We will not be notifying you if this is the case.
 - If you choose to not submit a quote, your quote will default to "Go Marines!"

Photos need to fit the following requirements:

1. Portrait should be **A HIGH QUALITY PHOTO**, either professionally done or done on a professional grade camera. If this is impossible for you, please contact the yearbook staff (BY SEPTEMBER 14th) and we will arrange to take a photo for you.
 - *Some cell phones have higher quality cameras on them which could work, but not all. Please be aware that if you take your portraits on your phone, we may deny them due to lack of quality.*
2. Portrait should be **SENT DIGITALLY** to yearbook@marinette.k12.wi.us
 - Your photographer may ask for this information: photos should be 3.5"x5.5", 300 dpi
3. Photo needs to be from the **WAIST UP**, with the student looking forward.
4. Students should be **DRESSED APPROPRIATELY**.
5. **NO PROPS** should be pictured with the student, including (but not limited to):
 - Cars
 - Snowmobiles
 - Dogs
 - Guns
 - Other people
6. Photos must not have anything in it that could be deemed inappropriate for school.

The Yearbook Staff has the right to refuse any picture from being in the yearbook that does not fit these requirements. If you have any questions, please email yearbook@marinette.k12.wi.us and we will respond as soon as possible.
