The Summer Institute (SI) is part of a national effort to improve college education in science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) and to enhance the academic success of *all* students by helping current and future faculty develop and adopt inclusive and effective teaching practices. The SI is a nationally recognized, prestigious teaching development program that has trained more than 1,000 faculty in evidence-based instruction over the last decade, including over 100 UCLA science faculty, some of whom will serve as facilitators of this esteemed 4-day institute this summer.

Also encouraged to apply are postdoctoral fellows in UPLIFT and the Chem/Biochem Teaching Scholars programs as well as graduate student TACs for UCLA's TA training courses.
