

What is Pierce County ICC:

Pierce County Interagency Coordinating Council coordinates and fosters development of a comprehensive countywide system of accessible Early Supports for Infants and Toddlers. The focus of PCICC is to ensure that families have access to a wide range of services and to help build local capacity.

What are Early Supports for Infants and Toddlers: All children grow and develop in unique ways. Some experience delays in their development. 'Early Intervention' refers to the services available to families with children under the age of three who are:

- not developing as expected
- have a medical condition that can delay normal development
- are for any other reason experiencing a developmental delay
