We are having a limited menu with Hamburgers, Hot Dogs, Chips, Drinks, Candy Bars, Nachos and Frosties. This means that you need fewer people per shift as there is not as much prep. **Please try to have shifts of at least 2 hours. One-hour shifts do not let workers get into a rhythm and learn their jobs before the next shift comes in.** If you have extra families who cannot be in the food stand due to numbers, they can help by cleaning trash out of the buildings and cleaning around the fairgrounds.

We will be opening the arena windows on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday evenings about 1 hour before the event starts.

Staffing for Food Stand:

2-3 Adults: 1 for grill, 1 for money (older teens can be used to cashier), 1 to compile orders.

4 Youth: 2 youth as order takers, 1 youth drink order filler, 1 order deliverer.

Please do not have more than 10 people in the food stand at one time.
