



# BANKS LOWMAN INTERSECTION



The Idaho Transportation Department is developing plans to improve the SH-55 Banks-Lowman Intersection in Boise County. Due to seasonal recreational attractions in the area, there are significant traffic increases during summer weekends at the intersection.

## PROJECT PROCESS

ITD is currently in the planning and design phase of a long-term improvement project for the Banks-Lowman Intersection. The planning and design process includes:

- Completing an environmental evaluation.
- Completing technical studies such as geotechnical and hydraulics work.
- Developing design and construction plans for the bridge and roadway.
- Working with the public throughout the process.

## IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDE


- Widening the intersection
- Replacing two bridges
- Installing a permanent traffic signal.

## PROJECT TIMELINE

<b>2025</b>	Initiate project and develop intersection improvements.
<b>2026–2027</b>	Develop preliminary design plans and environmental evaluation.
<b>2028</b>	Complete final design plans, when funds are available.
<b>TBD</b>	Construction will be scheduled when funds are available.
