



BANKS LOWMAN INTERSECTION



ITD added a temporary signal at the intersection in spring 2025 to reduce congestion.

The Idaho Transportation Department is developing plans to improve the SH-55 Banks-Lowman Intersection in Boise County. Due to seasonal recreational attractions in the area, there are significant traffic increases during summer weekends at the intersection.

PROJECT PROCESS

ITD is currently in the planning and design phase of a long-term improvement project for the Banks-Lowman Intersection. The planning and design process includes:

- Completing an environmental evaluation.
- Completing technical studies such as geotechnical and hydraulics work.
- Developing design and construction plans for the bridge and roadway.
- Working with the public throughout the process.

IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDE

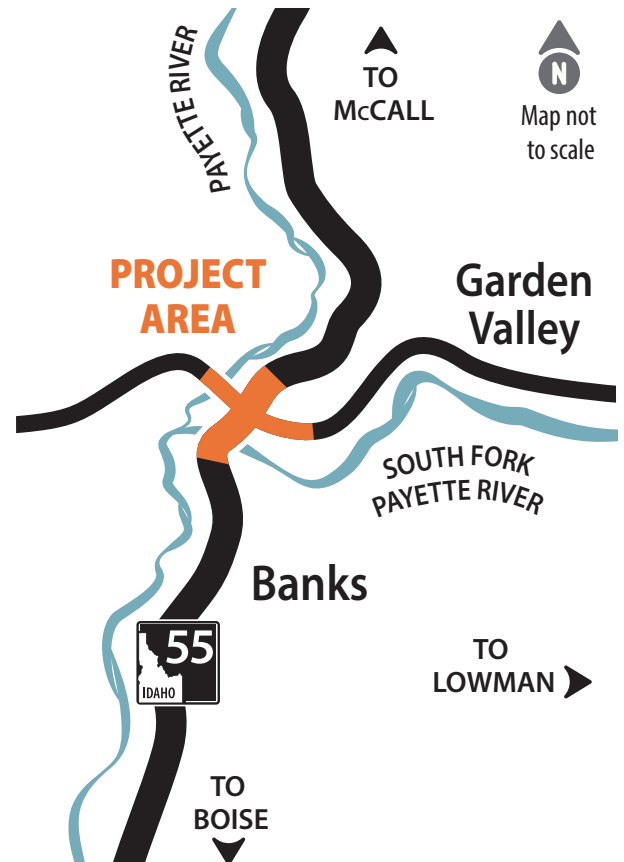
- Widening the intersection
- Replacing two bridges
- Installing a permanent traffic signal.

PROJECT TIMELINE

2025	Initiate project and develop intersection improvements.
2026–2027	Develop preliminary design plans and environmental evaluation.
2028	Complete final design plans, when funds are available.
TBD	Construction will be scheduled when funds are available.
