
Registration: Registration will be open on iclays.com

From 173 South (Hondo):

Coming into Bandera, turn left on to FM 1077 and go 1/2 mile (just past cemetery). Gun club is on the left.


From Hwy 16 (Kerrville):

Coming through Bandera, go straight from Hwy 16 N onto State Hwy 173 for 1/4 mile (cross the Medina River). Turn right onto FM 1077 and go 1/2 mile (just past cemetery). Gun club is on the left.

From Hwy 16 (San Antonio):

Coming into Bandera, turn left onto State Hwy 173, go 1/4 mile (cross the Medina River). Turn right onto FM 1077, go 1/2 mile (just past cemetery). Gun club is on the left.

From Bandera Gun Club:

Leave gun club by turning right on to FM 1077 and travel to State Hwy 173. Turn left on to State Hwy 173 (towards Bandera). Once in town, turn right at the True Value Store and continue past the cemetery towards Kerrville. Watch for sign to turn right into shooting fields off of Hwy 173.
