Registration: Registration opens September 22<sup>nd</sup> and will close on October 7<sup>th</sup>. After registration closes, Agents and Ag Teachers will be sent instructions for their participants to fill out the e-scantrons. ### **General Rules and Information**

- 1) There is no limit to the number of teams that Agricultural Science Teachers or County Extension Agents may enter
- 2) Participants must be a current 4-H or FFA member to compete
- 3) Age Divisions: Junior Division (3<sup>rd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> grade) and Senior (9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> grade)
- 4) Competing teams may consist of 3 or 4 members within the same age division. Scores of the 3 highest team members will compromise the team score
- 5) Individual participants may compete without a team.
- 6) All entries should be entered by the Ag Teacher or County Extension Agent on judgingcard.com by October 7<sup>th</sup>
- 7) Plants for the contest will be selected from the Master Plant List which may be found online at <https://www.judgingcard.com/resources/list.aspx>

### **Contest Rules and Information**

- 1) The contest will include 40 plants that may be either grasses, forbs, legumes or woody plants from the master plant list.
- 2) Participants will use a scantron to score the contest. (Plant Identification Form # 707-4) The cost for the e-scantron is included in the \$5.00 registration fee.
- 3) The list with plant names and numbers that participants will use to bubble in the scantron will be sent to all coaches, agents and ag teachers prior to the contest
- 4) The e-scantron will need to be submitted during the 9-11 AM time frame. Contest and instructions will be sent to participants before 9 AM, Saturday, October 15<sup>th</sup>.

- 5) Scoring will be done by points. If the plant name is incorrect, no points will be given for characteristics correctly identified.
- 6) Plants will be pictures of live plant specimens
- 7) Plant ID Key will be verified by Dr. Barron Rector, Associate Professor and Extension Range Specialist
- 8) Awards (ribbons) will be mailed to top placing teams and individuals after tabulation of scores.
