This past July, during our Junior Ryder Cup excursion to East Lothian, Scotland a suggestion was made by several juniors and parents to establish a “***Junior Golf Exchange Program***”.

What a great idea and now the planning stage is underway in both countries. Details for this exciting program will be forthcoming.

The current plan is for selected NFJG junior tour members to go to Scotland and stay with host families of the East Lothian Golf League. In return, several East Lothian Juniors will come here to Jacksonville to experience golf in the good ole U.S. of A.

FOR NOW I would like to know if you would be interested in having your junior travel to Scotland as part of this program and also if you would be interested in becoming a host home for one or even two of the Scottish juniors? Or maybe do BOTH?

The juniors may be boys or girls ages 13-18 (younger if approved by both coordinating bodies.)

In short, host families will need to be GREAT Ambassadors, provide room and board for the stay of our visiting juniors, reducing costs of their stay. Be willing to show our visitors a great time and leave them at the airport with fond memories of their stay. The Host Family will be responsible for putting together an agenda of activities which will be reported to the visiting juniors family members and league coordinator.

NOTE: Our Friends in Scotland get out of school in early July, so the dates to go to Scotland would be July 13-26, 2018 and fly back with the visiting East Lothian juniors who will stay in Jacksonville from July 27th until August 7th or 8th, 2018
