



The NFIJG TOUR's "**JUNIOR PLAYERS CUP**" (JPC) will be a six tournament contest to identify the NFIJG TOUR Player who will represent the **North Florida Junior Golf Foundation and Tour** in the 2021 **American Junior Golf Association's (AJGA) "JUNIOR PLAYERS CHAMPIONSHIP"**.

This annual event is held at **TPC Sawgrass** on the renowned **Stadium Course**. This year's event is scheduled for September 2-5, 2021 where the nation's top junior players will compete for the title as "JUNIOR PLAYERS CHAMPION" and join the list of past champions since 2007.

The 2020 Champion, David Ford reigns from Peachtree Corners, Ga who posted scores of 72-73-66—211 (-5) on his way to victory.

Past participants include Jordan Spieth, Justin Thomas, Brooks Koepka, Patrick Cantlay, Blayne Barber, Bud Cauley and the list goes on. The JUNIOR PLAYERS record is -9 under par 63 shot by Logan McCallister in 2017. The 54-hole record is -10 under par shot by Kavish Varadan in 2016 (73-65-68—206).

The NFIJGF representative will be determined via a "JUNIOR PLAYERS CUP" points list. Points will be awarded and accumulated over six predetermined NFIJGTOUR tournaments (listed below). The top 12 point leaders and the top two Elite Tour "Player of the Year" point leaders at the end of this series of tournaments will compete in a final 3-day qualifier at World Golf Village-Slammer and Squire and San Jose Country Club during the "North Florida Junior Amateur" to determine the winner.

Eligible tournaments to earn JPC points are:

- The Titleist Invitational – May 1-2, 2021
- The Dr. Gordon Ira Golf Classic – June 16-17, 2021
- The JAX Beach Junior Open – June 21-22, 2021
- The St. Augustine Junior – July 5-6, 2021
- The Greater Jacksonville Junior Championship – July 12-13, 2021

- The North Florida Junior Amateur – July 24-26, 2021 (top 12 in points standing)*

Note: Only NFIJGTOUR Members (Boys 13-18) may earn JPC points.
