The remainder of the afternoon and evening are at leisure.

Day 4 – Historic Québec City, Friday, August 13 - Breakfast Included

Today's guided sightseeing tour introduces you to one of the most beautiful cities in North America. Highlights include: Upper Town, Château Frontenac, Dufferin Terrace, Funicular Ride, Petit-Champlain District, Place Royale.
