DAY 1: APRIL 27

CAPE TOWN

As you enter the arrivals hall, look for an African Travel Inc. representative, holding a sign with your name on it. You will be assisted to your transfer vehicle. Transfer to your hotel with the remaining at leisure.

DAY 2: APRIL 28

CAPE TOWN

Embark on a day of discovering the Cape Peninsula. Continue along the pristine coastline, discovering the quaint towns along "The Fairest Cape." Hug the cliffs as you snake along legendary Chapman's Peak Drive to the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve. You will have the opportunity to ride the Flying Dutchman funicular to the old lighthouse for awe-inspiring views! After lunch, continue along the coast to the lively penguin colony at Boulders Beach. Then head back to the city via

the naval village of Simon's Town and enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure. (BL)

DAY 3: APRIL 29 CAPE TOWN

This morning, visit Robben Island where Nelson Mandela was incarcerated for 18 years. This historic landmark and UNESCO site pays tribute to the triumph of freedom and human dignity.



The afternoon begins with a cable car ride up to the summit of the legendary Table Mountain, where you can enjoy breathtaking views of the city. After descending the mountain, drive past the Castle of Good Hope, the country's oldest building, and a short distance away, the Company Gardens, both historically fascinating and well-conserved. Nearby landmarks include the Slave Lodge, Houses of Parliament and City Hall, where Nelson Mandela



made his first public speech after his release from prison in 1990. Marvel at the vibrant colors of the quaint Bo-Kaap homes in the Malay Quarter. Evening at leisure. (B)

DAY 4: APRIL 30

CAPE WINELANDS

Today's private sojourn combines wine tasting and an unforgettable art experience in the beautiful Cape Winelands. DAY 5: MAY 1

CAPE TOWN / KAPAMA PRIVATE GAME RESERVE

DAY 6: MAY 2

KAPAMA PRIVATE GAME RESERVE

Twice-daily game drives throughout the reserve, accompanied by expert guides and trackers, provide plenty of opportunities to witness the plethora of local wildlife.

Kapama Private Game Reserve is known as the "African Eden." This slice of wilderness paradise is secluded from crowds and home to the Big Five as well as more than 40 other mammal species and 350 different types of birds. Kapama is the largest owner-managed private game reserve



in the area, encompassing 13,000 hectares of sweeping wilderness. The reserve is also one of Africa's premier ecotourism destinations. Witness a magnificent African sunset while sipping a sundowner somewhere in the bush before celebrating with dinner back at the lodge. (BLD) KAPAMA RIVER LODGE



DAY 7: MAY 3 KAPAMA / JOHANNESBURG

Take one last early morning game drive before embarking on a flight to Johannesburg. Upon arrival, you will be met at the airport and transferred to your hotel. Enjoy the afternoon at leisure. (B)

DAY 8: MAY 4 JOHANNESBURG

Delve deeper into South Africa's turbulent past with a trip to Soweto, a sprawling multicultural metropolis of more than 3.5 million people on the outskirts of Johannesburg. Visit Freedom Square, the Hector Pieterson Memorial and Vilakazi Street, formerly home to both Nelson Mandela and Archbishop Desmond Tutu. After lunch, visit the Apartheid Museum for a deeper look at the humbling and ultimately inspiring journey from the dark days of segregation to Mandela's release from prison, and his policy of reconciliation rather than retribution. DAY 9: MAY 5

JOHANNESBURG / VICTORIA FALLS, ZIMBABWE

You will be transferred to Johannesburg Airport for your flight to Victoria Falls. Transfer to your hotel. Straddling the borders of Zimbabwe and Zambia, the grandeur and beauty of this extraordinary natural phenomenon must be seen to be believed. In the afternoon enjoy a tranquil sunset cruise on the Zambezi River. The park offers outstanding natural, scenic beauty with a wide diversity of game and bird life. Sit back and be lulled by the ebb and flow of the great river as you drift quietly pass elephants, hippos and crocodiles. (B)

DAY 10: MAY 6 VICTORIA FALLS

Visit an actual homestead in the village, talking to those who live and work there, and watching their lifestyle and cultural norms. 


Victoria & Alfred Hotel Cape Town

The hotel is located in the very heart of this internationally acclaimed destination and is a sophisticated retreat amid the buzz. It offers some of the most enviable views of Cape Town Harbour, Table Mountain and the slick city that stretches out at the foot of this Natural Wonder.

Victoria & Alfred Waterfront Hotel Timeless elegance and personalized luxury are found at the award-winning Victoria & Alfred Hotel. Attention to detail, its elegance and an outstanding reputation have set this hotel apart as one of Cape Town's finest establishments. A luxurious stay awaits at each of the 94 well-appointed, contemporary rooms, with views of the Alfred Basin, Table Mountain or the piazza. Kapama River Lodge

Kapama River Lodge is positioned along a bend of the seasonal Kapama River. Decorated to reflect old Africa, the air-conditioned suites feature full, en-suite bathrooms and private patios with uninterrupted views over the Big Five game reserve. Amenities include fans, hairdryers, mini-bar, safe, telephone, Wi-Fi internet access and tea/coffee making facilities. The central lodge area includes an enclosed dining area, where breakfasts and lunches are served and a bar and lounge with two large fireplaces. Evening meals are often enjoyed seated around a crackling fire in the Rhino Boma, where buffet meals showcase the pan-African dishes. The large rim-flow swimming pool is the perfect place to relax on a lazy afternoon.

Activities at Kapama include morning and afternoon game drives in open safari vehicles and guided bush walks, conducted by experienced rangers. All game viewing drives and walks are shared with fellow camp guests.



Palm River Hotel

The Palm River Hotel is set along the banks of the iconic Zambezi River among towering indigenous trees, not far from Africa's Natural World Wonder - Victoria Falls. The hotel has been inspired by the architectural style of the Queenslander and combined with the blend of East-Coast Australian design creates a unique environment of comfort and luxury.
