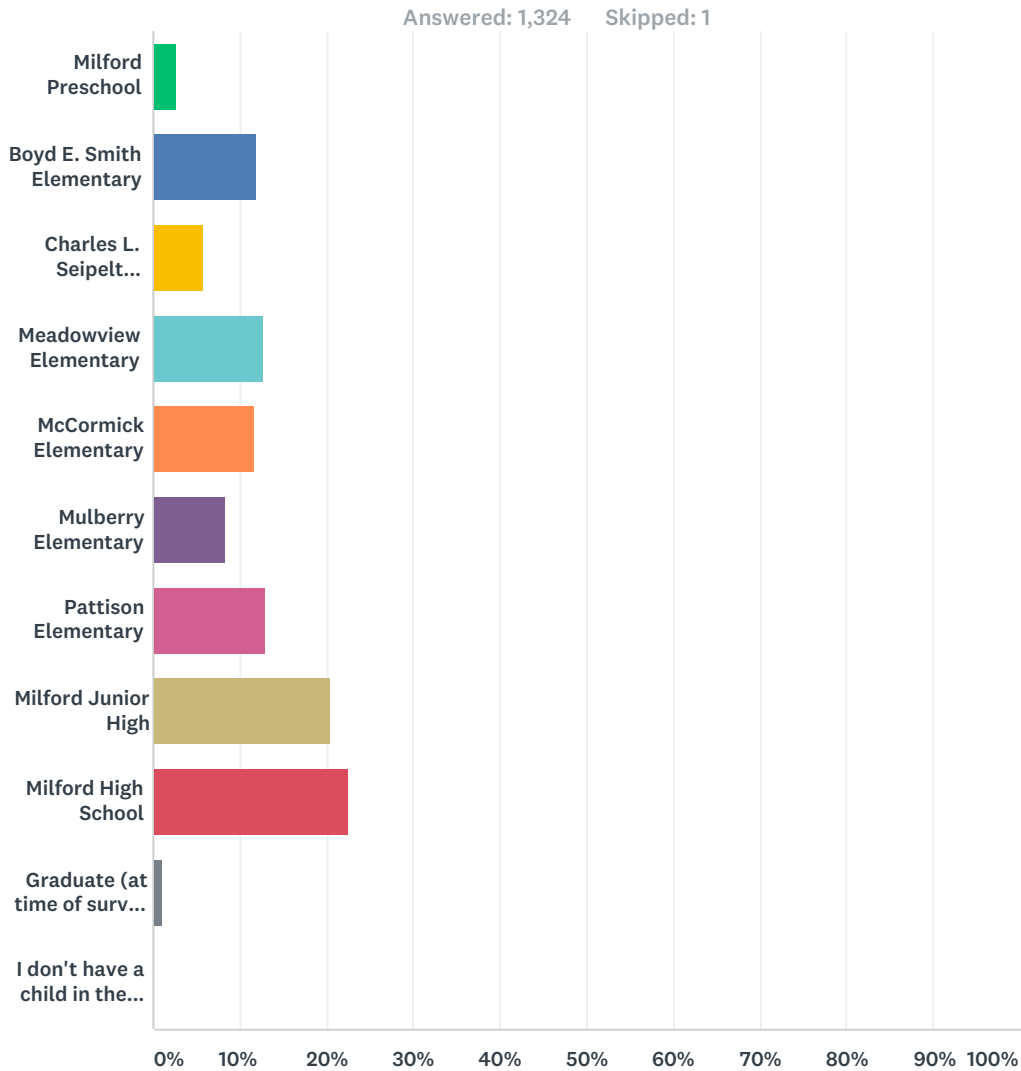

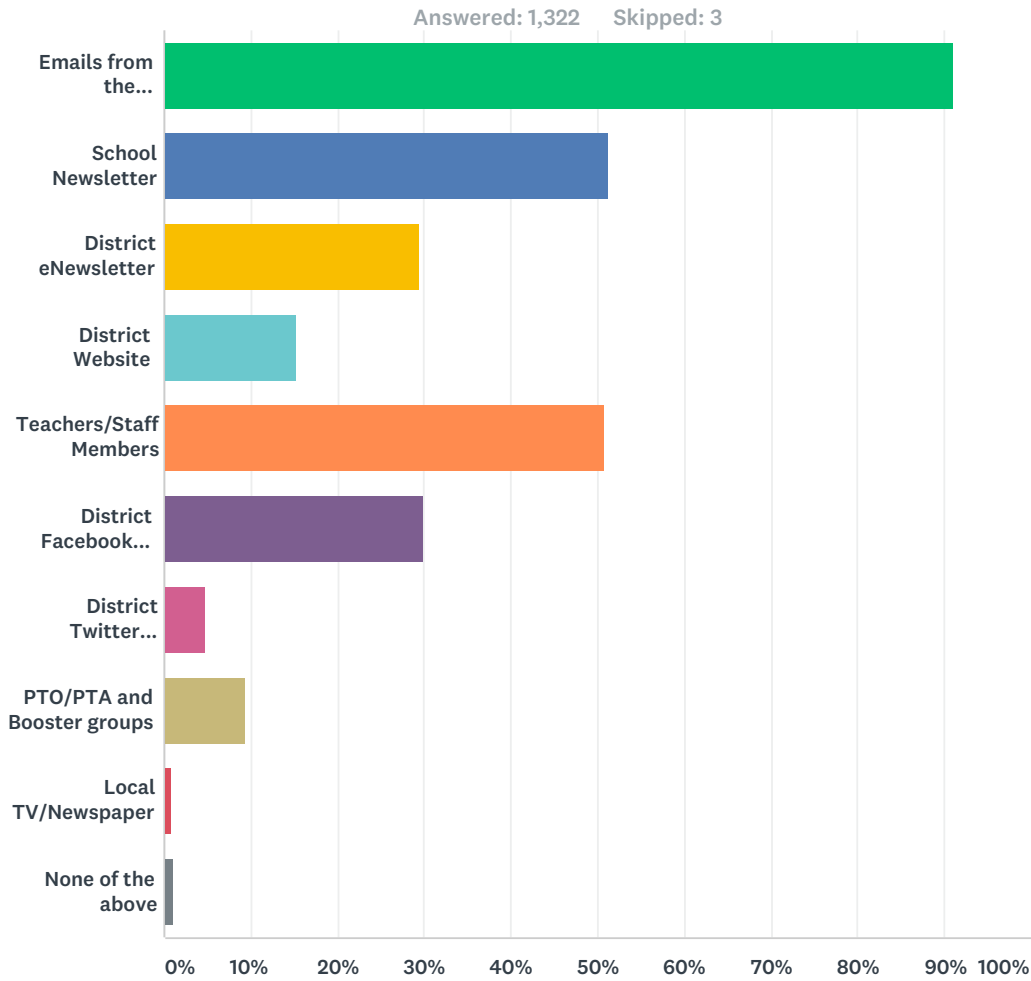

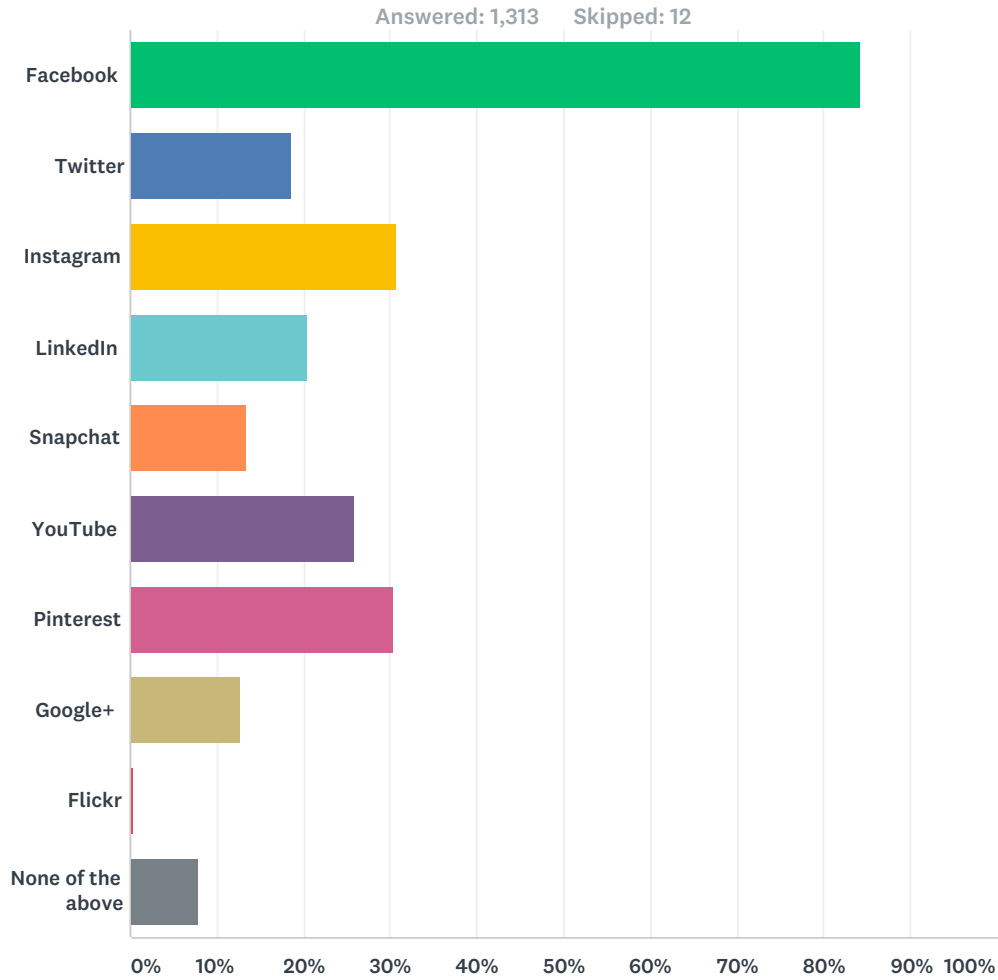

Q2 How do you receive most of your information about Milford Schools? (Check all that apply)



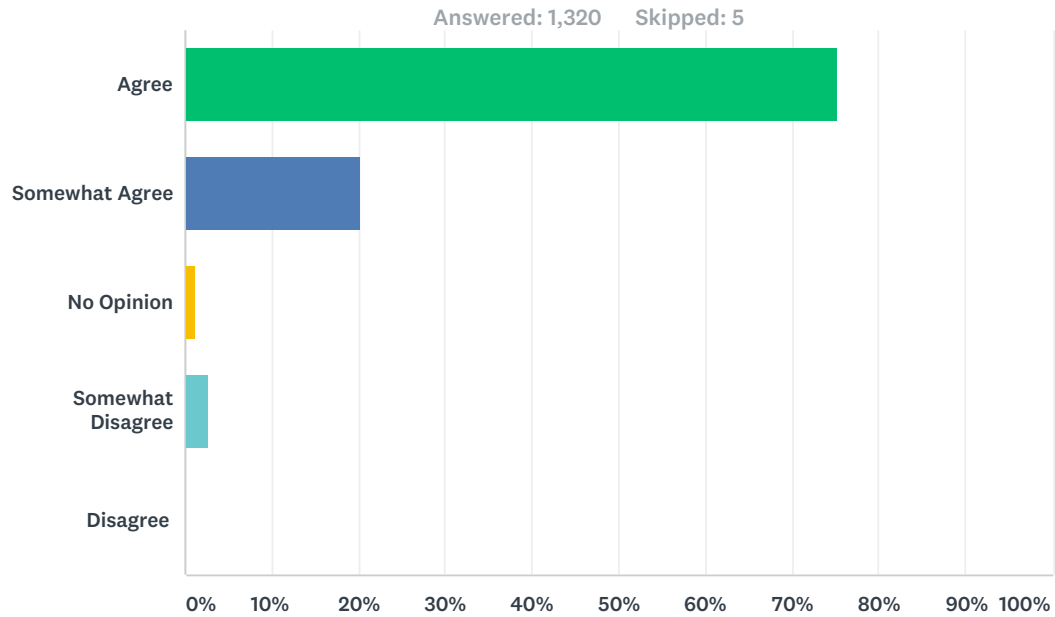

Q3 Which social media do you use? Check all that apply.



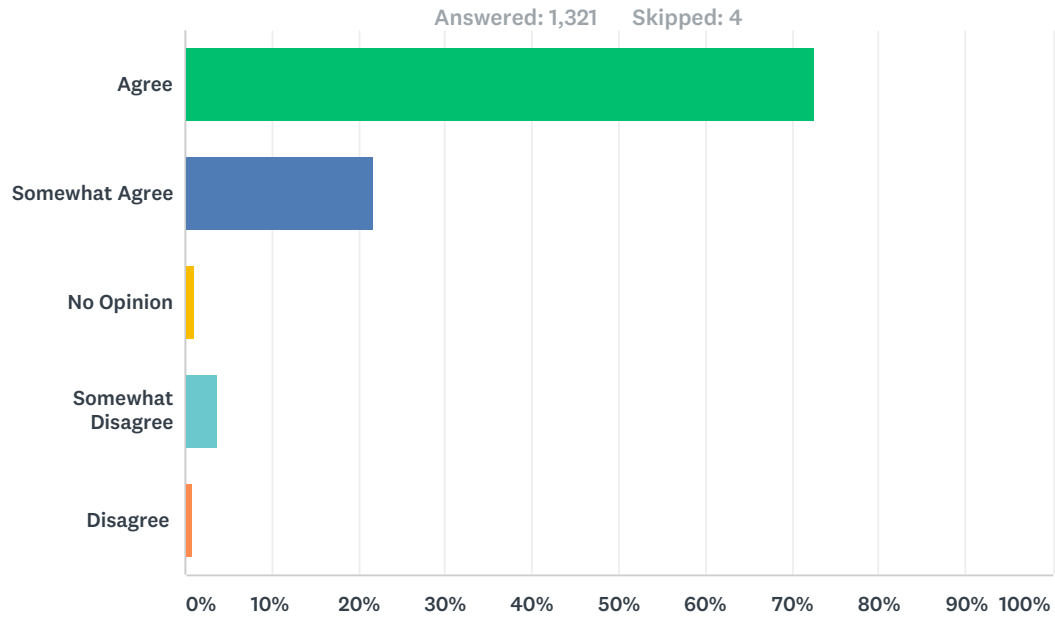

Q4 Milford School District communicates important information in a timely and effective manner.



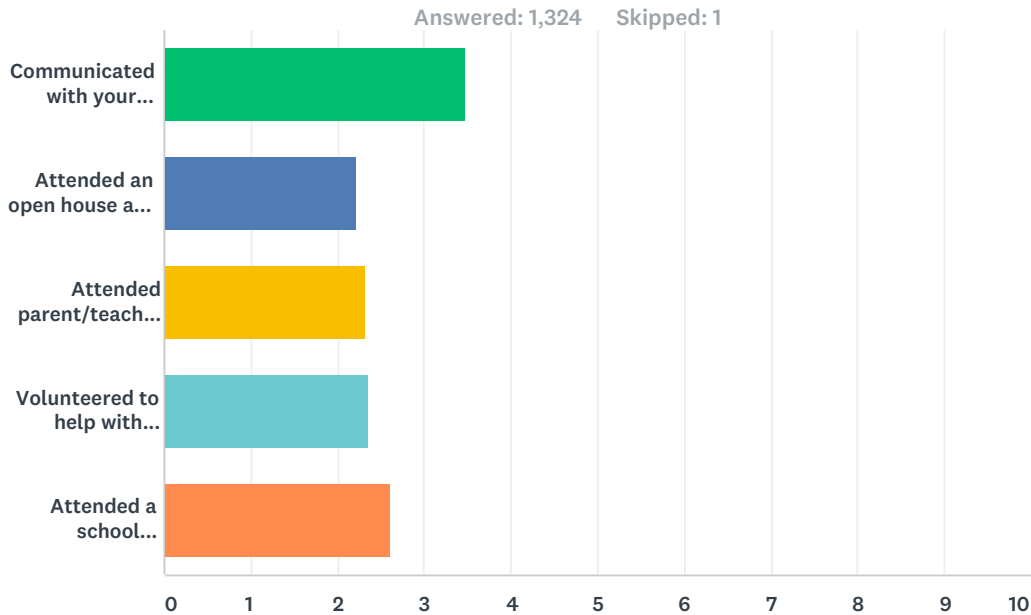

Q5 My child's school communicates important information in a timely and effective manner.



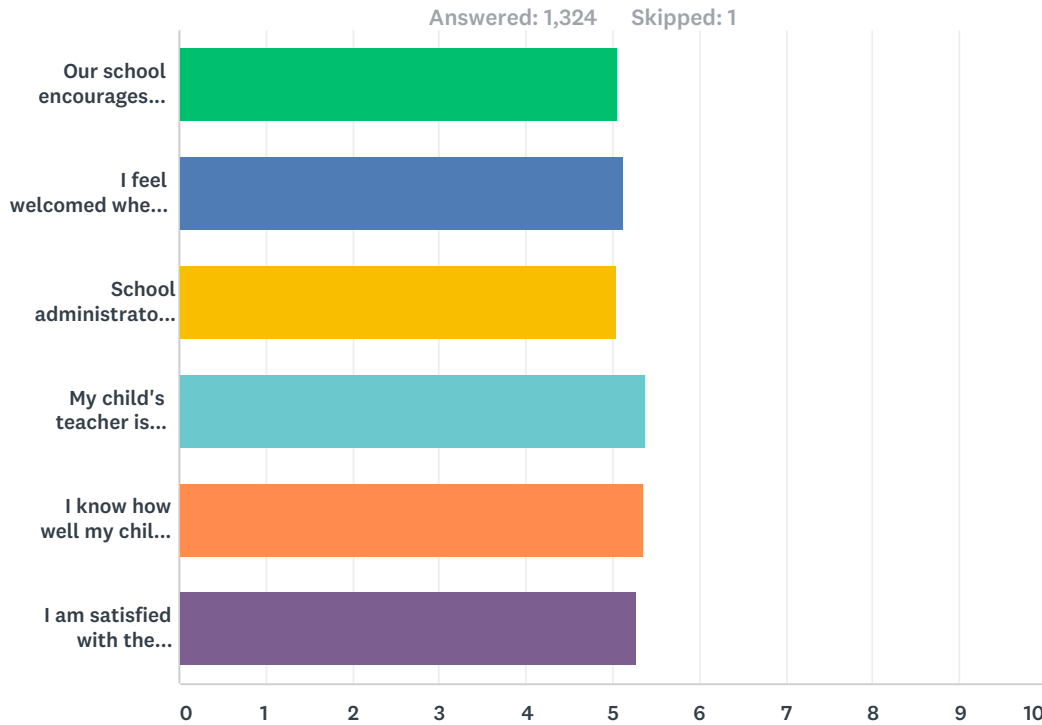

Q6 Select the option that best describes your level of participation in the following during the 2016-17 school year.



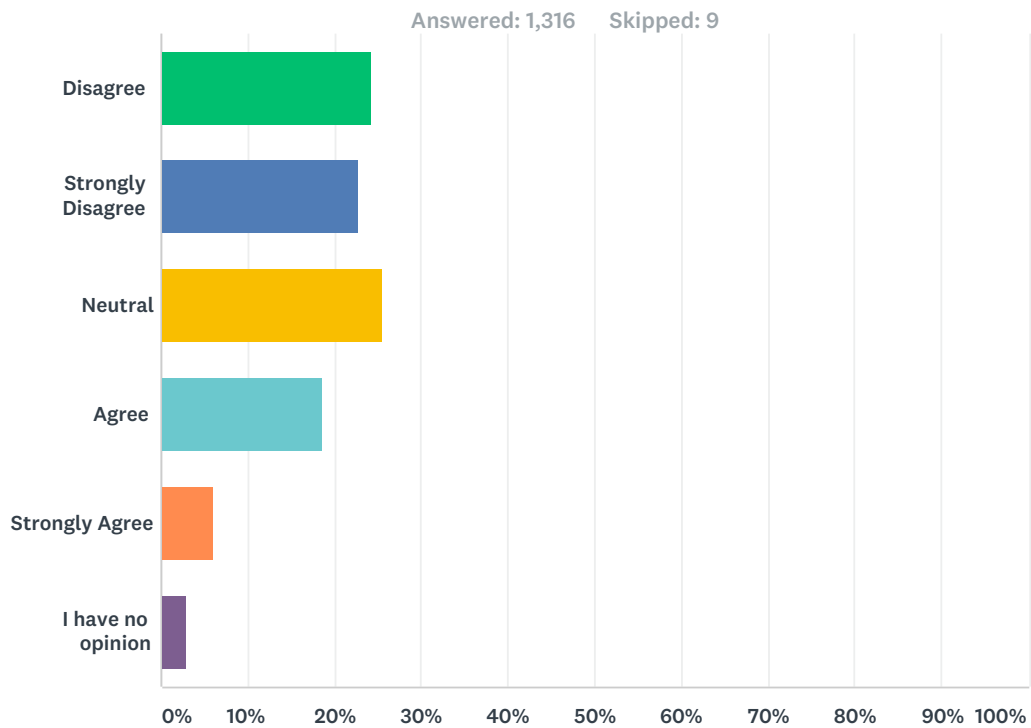

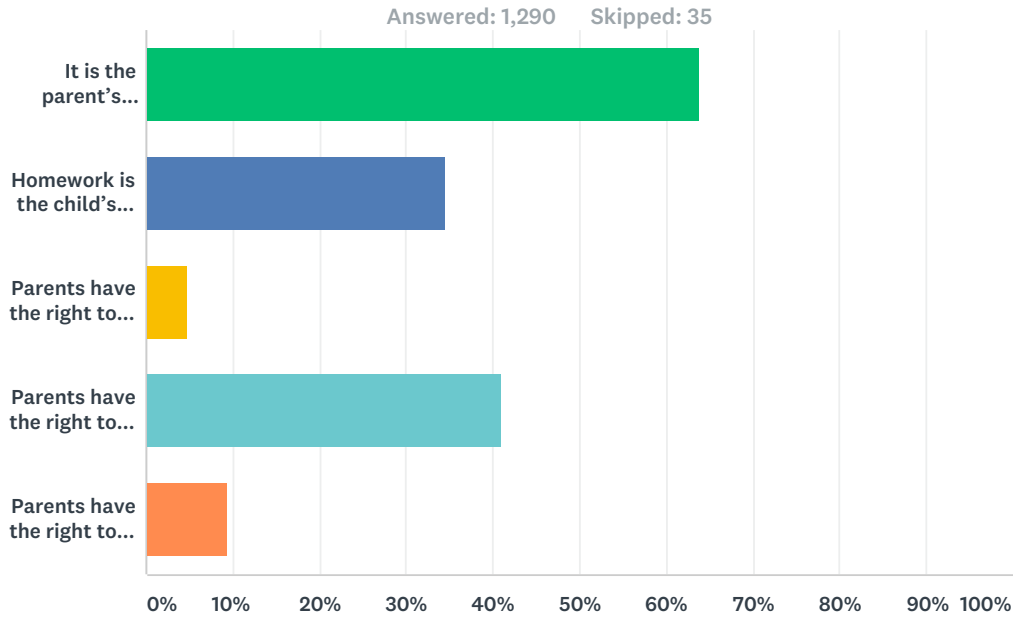

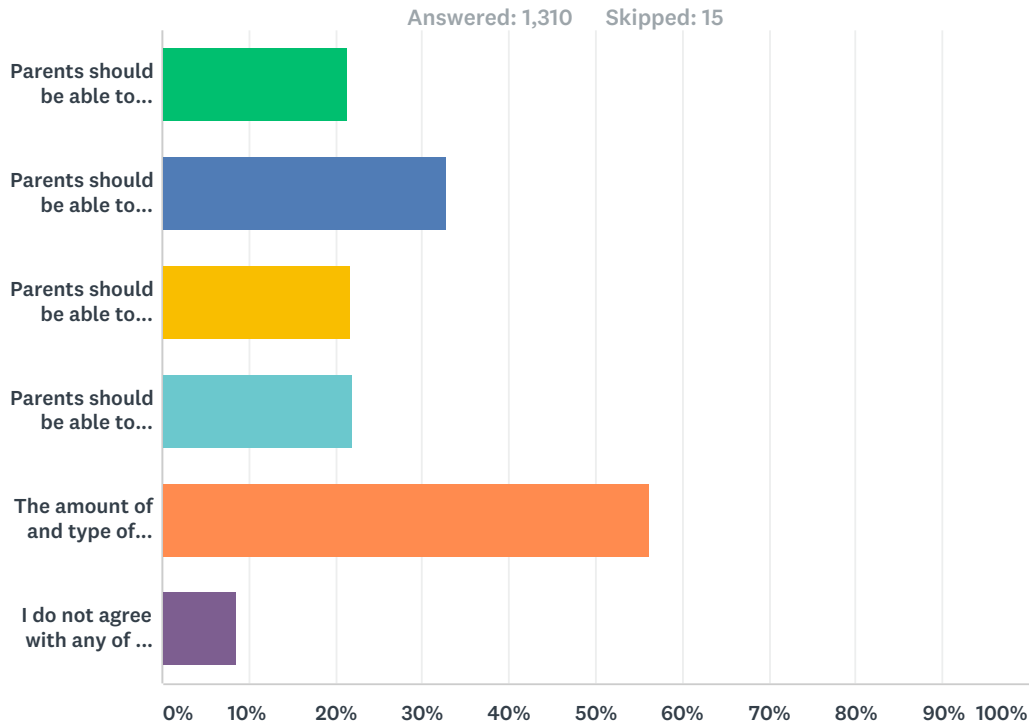

Q9 Who is in charge of homework? Check all that apply.



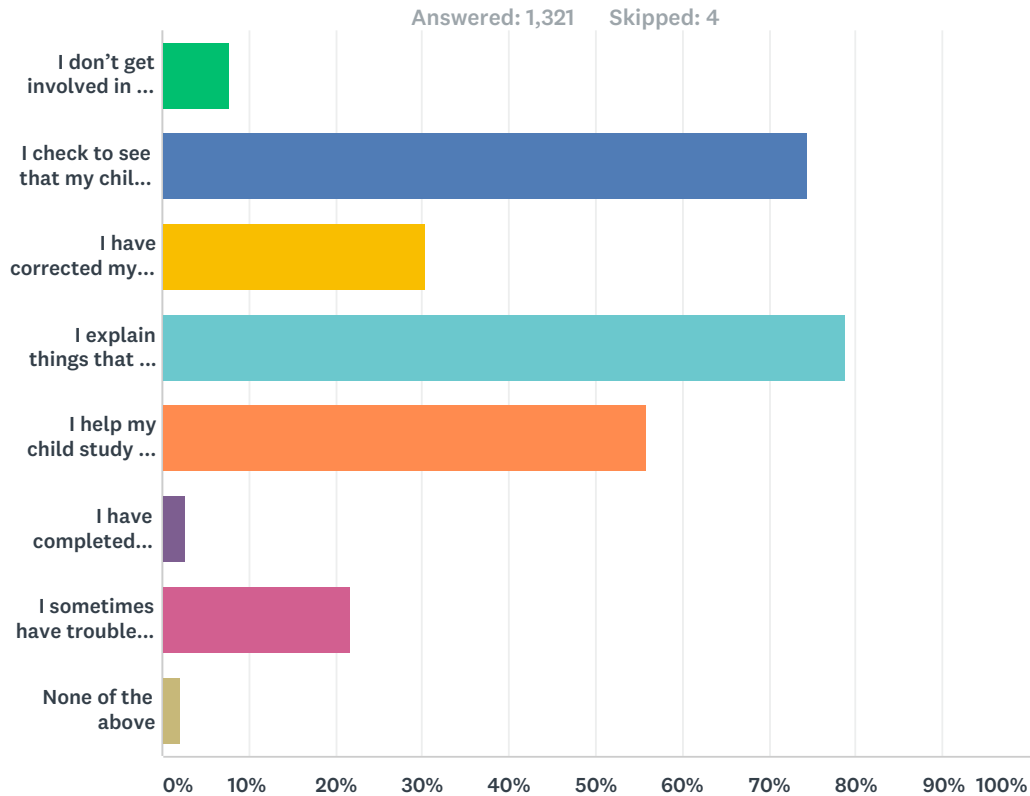

Q10 How much control should parents have over the amount and type of homework their child has? Check all that apply.



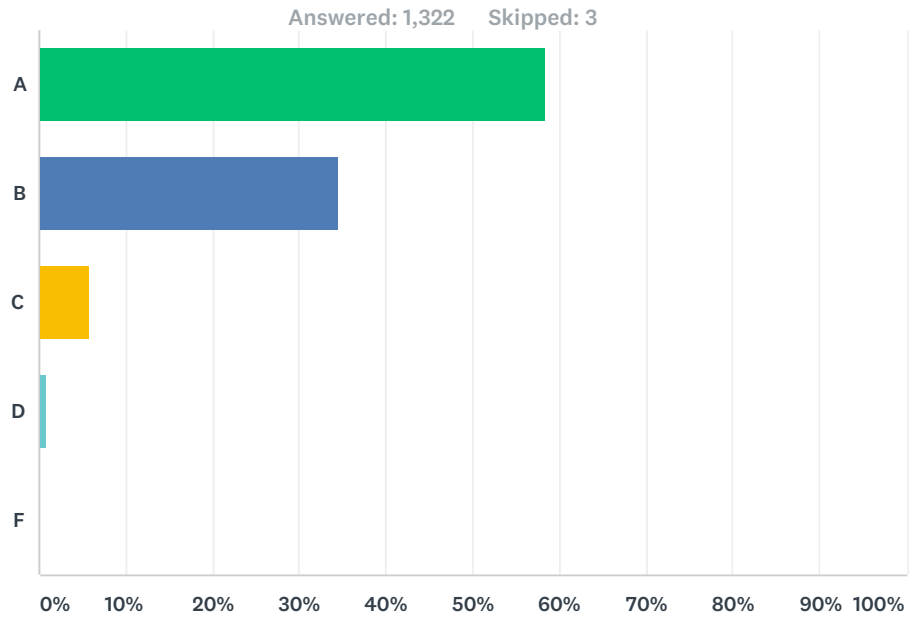

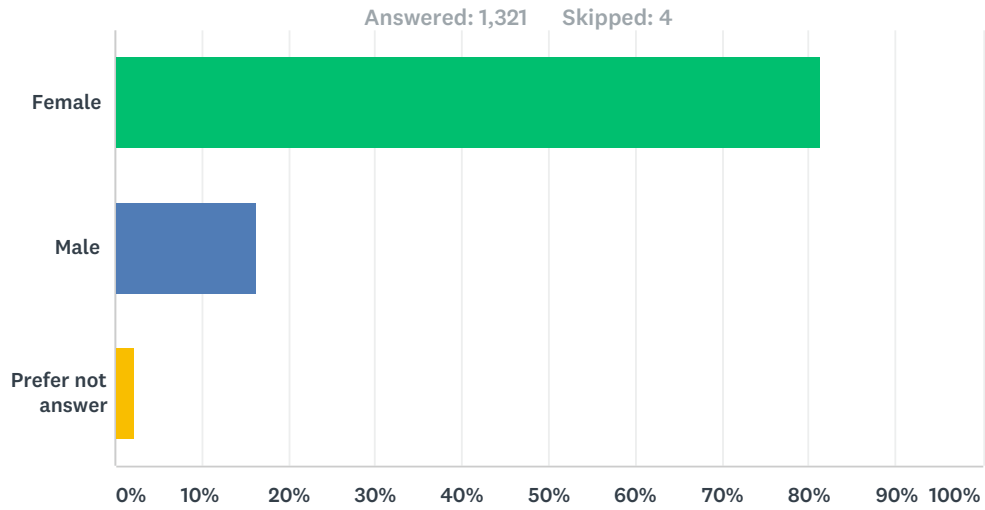

Q12 On a grading scale of “A” being the best and “F” for failing, what grade would you give Milford Schools?



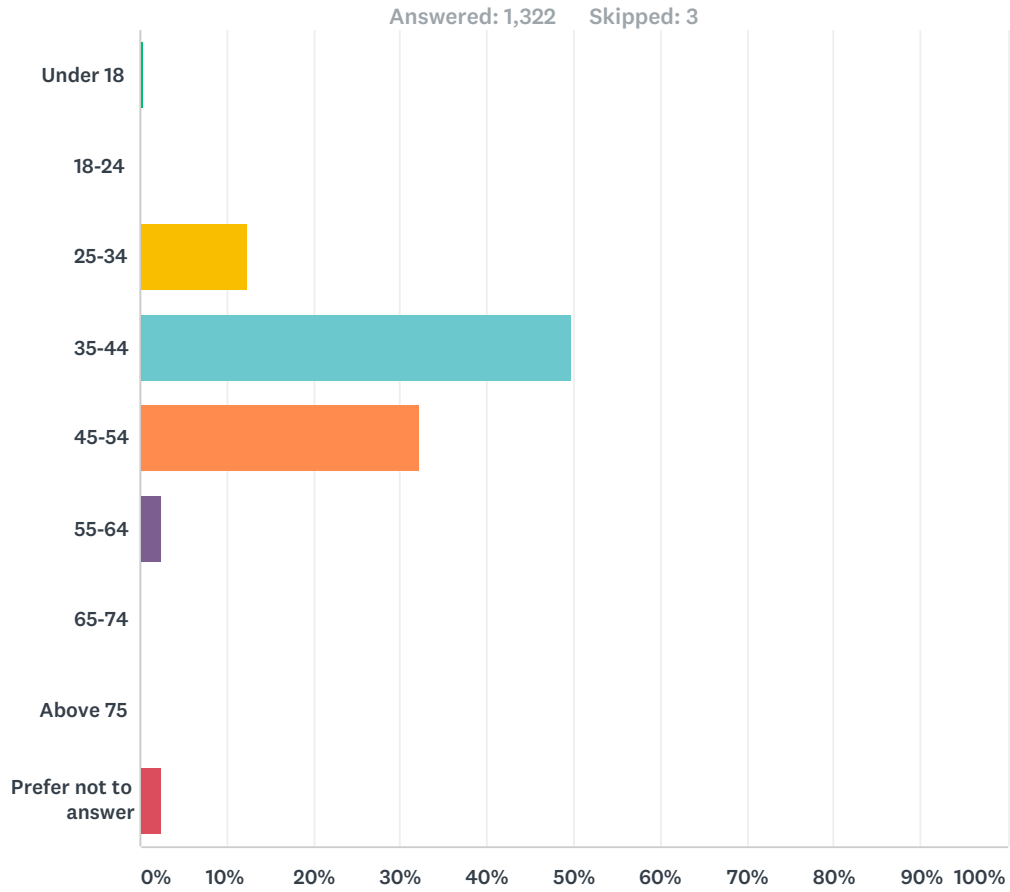

Q13 The last three questions are demographic questions. What is your gender?



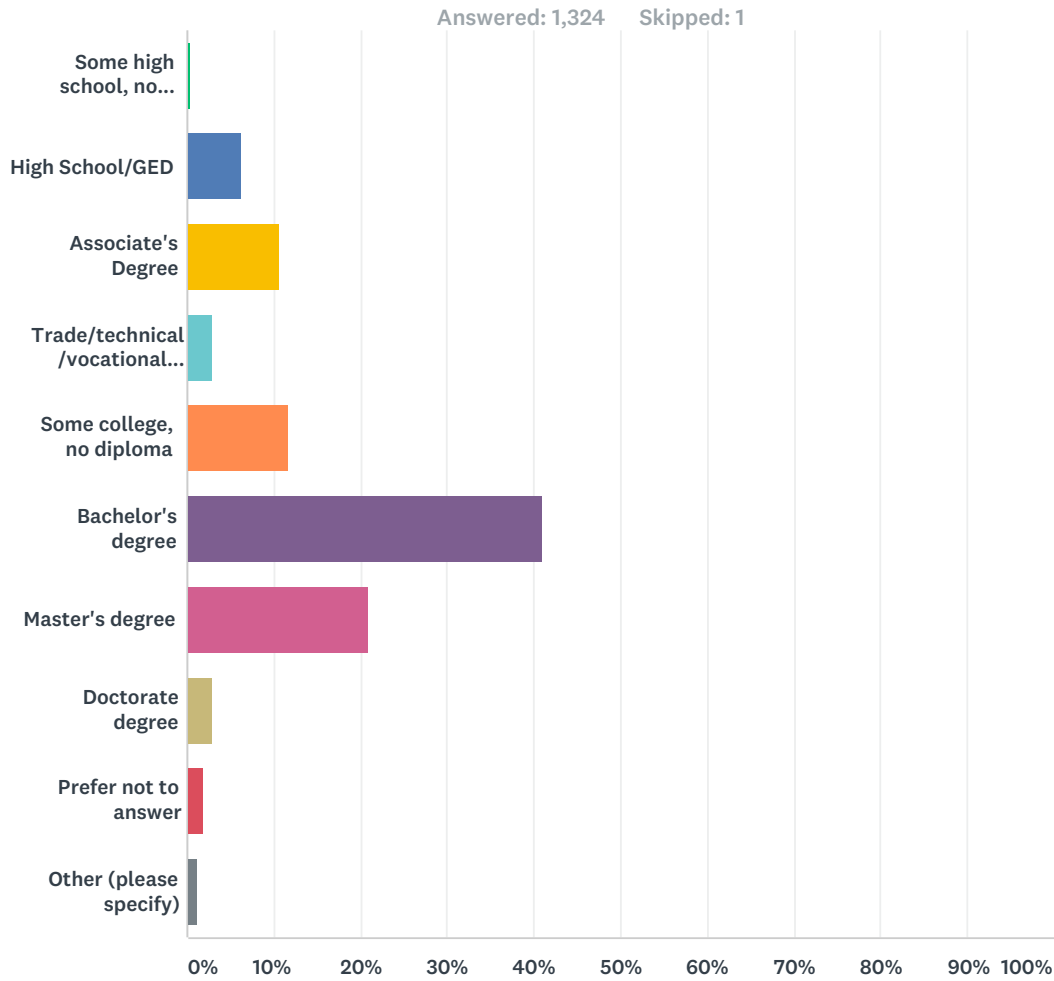
