SPIRIT WEEK

HOMECOMING PARADE

The community is invited to drive through campus to show their support.

PEP RALLY

When athletic schedules were recreated in August, the **Football** game on October 2 was moved to an away game. Student Council decided to keep Spirit Week and Homecoming this week as there was no way to have Homecoming activities during a Football game due to restricted crowds at athletic events.

HOMECOMING DANCE

The **Homecoming Dance** on October 3rd will be a “Stay at HOMECOMING” dance. Student Council will create a playlist so that students can have their own small, social distanced event at home on that day. Student Council will encourage students who participate to share/post pictures of their events.
