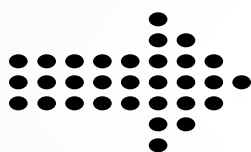


Back-To-School Teen Immunization Clinic

to offer incoming 7th and 12th grade students
vaccinations for the 2019-2020 school year

Required
school vaccines offered at
this clinic:



- 7th grade: one dose of Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis); one dose of meningococcal (MCV4)
- 12th grade: two doses of meningococcal (MCV4)

Recommended
school vaccines offered at
this clinic:



- Hepatitis A
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV)
- Meningococcal B

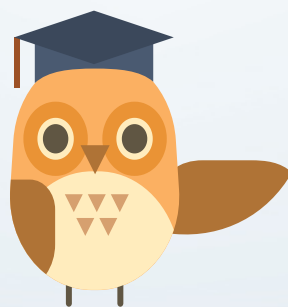
Not sure if your child needs to receive these vaccines?
Check with your child's healthcare provider or school nurse.

IMPORTANT CLINIC INFORMATION please read!

Students must be registered for the clinic at least one week prior to the scheduled clinic date. Students who are not registered will not be seen at this clinic.

- Complete the electronic registration form and consent.
- Click "Done" to complete your registration.



- Vaccines will not be given unless a parent or legal guardian is present.
- Children with health insurance must bring their insurance card. Most private insurance and Medicaid plans accepted.
- All children presenting for vaccination must bring a current immunization record.
- VFC (Vaccines for Children) offered - no VFC eligible child will be refused shots due to an inability to pay. VFC children include those under 19 years of age who are uninsured, are American Indian or Alaskan Native.
