



REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) #255

Service Provider Organizations for the Federal D. Glover Community Wellness Network

The Office of Racial Equity and Social Justice (ORESJ) on behalf of the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors, announces Request for Proposals (RFP) #255. The purpose of this solicitation is to identify organizations to provide rapid response services within the Federal D. Glover Community Wellness Network (FGCWN) as outlined in the Implementation Plan approved by the Board of Supervisors on August 12, 2025. This RFP process addresses a subset of the needs brought forth through community input and is designed to create an accessible opportunity for organizations of varying sizes and capacities to receive funding to expand and augment their services.

Vendors must be able to clearly articulate understanding of the demographics, experiences, and needs of diverse, multi-generational Black/African American communities and residents, and demonstrate expertise in engaging, communicating, partnering, and/or serving the Black/African American community and other marginalized communities of color.

Through this RFP, the County seeks to award contracts to community-based organizations to serve as Service Providers within the FGCWN for a two (2) year period, with an additional one (1) year renewal. The proposed term is January 1, 2027 to December 31, 2029 (depending on Board of Supervisors approval and subject to change). By investing in organizations already embedded in communities, the County aims to expand access to culturally grounded, responsive, and community-centered care. Awards are contingent on annual fund balance, satisfactory evaluation, contract monitoring, and overall contract performance.

The County anticipates awarding up to \$1.25 million annually through this RFP, for a total of \$3.75 million over three years. The County anticipates allocating approximately 85% annually to 1) Behavioral health services, 2) Family, maternal and child health, 3) Reentry support and restorative alternatives, 4) Housing navigation services and 15% annually to 5) Preventative health care, check-ups, and screening and 6) Public benefit resource navigation.

Interested parties are invited to attend a **Virtual Bidders' Information Session**. Attendance at either virtual session is not required for a proposal to be considered. 1. Go to Contra Costa County's BidNet Direct at the following link:

2. Click the "Vendor Registration" link at the top right of the page
3. Select the "Basic Plan", which is free of charge.

Unlike other BidNet subscriptions, the Contra Costa BidNet webpage is free and you may view, download and apply to this RFP for free. Be sure to "Remove" any add-ons BidNet includes with your Basic Plan registration.

4. Once registered, you will receive an email from BidNet Direct to finalize your account registration.
5. Suggest "Consultation Services" NAICS code 91800
6. Upon initial log in, you will be asked to create an account profile with:
 - a. Your organization's contact information
 - b. Service categories (e.g. 91800: Consulting Services)
 - c. Business structure
