EMERGENCY ROADWAY AND SOUNDWALL REPAIRS PROMPT TEMPORARY ON-RAMP CLOSURE ON SOUTHBOUND I-680 IN DANVILLE

Schedule: Tuesday, January 20, 2026, through June 2026 (weather permitting)

CONTRA COSTA COUNTY — Caltrans District 4 has scheduled emergency repair work on southbound Interstate 680 (I-680) in the City of Danville, requiring a temporary closure of the **El Cerro Boulevard** on-ramp to **southbound I-680**.

This work is necessary to address roadway and soundwall conditions that require immediate attention to maintain safety. Construction activities will include emergency roadway repairs, soundwall repairs, and related work.

Ramp Closure Information

- Location: El Cerro Boulevard on-ramp to southbound I-680
- Date: Tuesday night, January 20, 2026, (Tentative Closure 1-21-2026)
- Time: 9:00 PM to 5:00 AM
- **PLEASE NOTE:** One night is anticipated; up to two nights if necessary

Construction Schedule

Emergency repair work is expected to continue through June 2026, weather permitting.

- Day Work: Monday–Friday, 7:00 AM to 3:30 PM
- Night Work (as needed): 9:00 PM to 5:00 AM

What to Expect

- Drivers may experience delays during work hours. Some activities may result in increased noise, lighting, or traffic-related impacts. Caltrans and its contractor will make every effort to minimize disruptions and complete the work safely and efficiently.
- Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead, allow extra travel time, and drive cautiously through the work zone.

Detour Information

During the temporary closure of the El Cerro Boulevard on-ramp:

- Motorists traveling to southbound I-680 should use alternate nearby on-ramps, including Stone Valley Road or Sycamore Valley Road, as appropriate.
