



- Substance Abuse is the number one health issue in Jefferson County.

### **What is Road to Recovery?**

Road to Recovery is a program developed by members of Healthy Communities of Jefferson County whose goal is to transport more people in Jefferson County suffering from substance abuse to out of town treatment centers. Each Guide (driver/mentor) in the program will be provided with training and support.
