ARPEC's COVID-19 Safety Protocols

Screening protocol prior to attending classes in person:

- You must arrive 30 minutes before your scheduled start time to allow time for our safety protocols, including a temperature screening. Screenings will take place in front of the blue doors by the picnic tables (the rear entrance) once you arrive at the school, line up on the markers outside of the back entrance of the school, which will be spaced at least 6 feet apart. You will be required to have your own face mask.
- Each person that will be entering the building will have their temperature taken with an infrared thermometer. Apprentices or members will be discretely notified if their body temperature is, or is not, within the normal range.
- Anybody with a body temperature in excess of the normal range will be asked to return to his/her vehicle and exit the premises.
- If the temperature screening results are in-range temperature attendees will receive a green dot which means that their temperature was taken and in range after that the attendees be allowed to enter the building.
- Once you have entered the building attendees will be required to proceed to the restroom and wash their hands in accordance to the CDC recommendation on how to properly wash your hands.
- CDC recommendations will be posted in the restroom for guidance.
- After washing of the hands are completed, apprentices /members will be allowed to enter their designated classrooms.

While in the building:

- All instructors, apprentices or members will be required to wear his/her face masks at all times while they are in the building.
- You may only enter the building through the east doors (by the picnic tables.)
- You must exit the building at all times through the west doors (by the main office)

Common area protocols:

- School restrooms will be open for use as needed
- Hand sanitizer dispenser are available throughout the building
- ARPEC employees are also required to wear a face mask all times while they are in the building, whether they are part of the class or not.
- If you are given a break by your instructor it is best practice to proceed to your vehicle.
- If you chose to not proceed to your vehicle and stay outside of our building you must practice safe social distancing practices.
- Picnic tables will be off limit until further notice.

Everybody who is in the building will be required to abide by these protocols, in its entirety, as a prerequisite for participating in any class.
