What Is Leadership Beatrice?

Leadership Beatrice is a ten session program presented by the Beatrice Area Chamber of Commerce that seeks to identify, educate and develop citizens of the Beatrice area for positions of community leadership. Class participants will be exposed to new ways of thinking, develop ideas, and increase their knowledge of their community.

Generally, the ten sessions are held on the third Wednesday of the month, August through May. Each session focuses on a different aspect of the community, allowing participants the opportunity to learn about the community.

The classes are conducted at different businesses across Beatrice and are planned by the Leadership Beatrice Advisory committee.

Each year the class participants complete the Strengths Finder profile and receive extensive training about this program. (The books are generously donated by Exmark Manufacturing, Inc.)

The class collaborates to choose a project that benefits their community, and combine their resources to bring that project to fruition.

What Are Attendance Requirements?

To graduate Leadership Beatrice, attendance to all sessions is strongly encouraged. Participants may be absent up to 16 hours (2 class days). Sessions may be made up the following year, which then qualifies participant for graduation with approval from the Leadership Beatrice Advisory Committee.
