SUMMER 2025 UPDATE

The Arizona Caregiver Coalition is proud to share progress on the Arizona Family Caregiver Action Plan, a statewide effort to strengthen supports for family caregivers across Arizona.

The Action Plan is guided by three work groups: Access to Services, Advocacy, and Education. Each work group is composed of professionals, community partners, and family caregivers working together to improve caregiving in Arizona.

ACCESS TO SERVICES

- **Decision Tree Platform** – We've met with technology partners to develop a streamlined, "No Wrong Door" resource directory for family caregivers.
- **Crisis Response Integration** – Establishing a coordinated response system to ensure caregivers facing crisis can be connected to services and

resources within 24 hours.

ADVOCACY

- **Statewide Advocacy Assessment** – Mapping existing advocacy efforts to avoid duplication and maximize impact.
- **Data Collection Strategy** – Reviewing what data exists on Arizona's caregivers, what's missing, and how to use data for policy change.

EDUCATION & TRAINING

- **Partnering with Community Colleges & CHW Programs** – Collaborating on how family caregiving is taught and supported across Arizona.
