Wear a mask.

Wear your own mask or face covering during Mass. Masks are required for anyone age 2 and older.



Sanitize your hands.

Practice good hand hygiene by washing your hands with soap and water or using alcohol or hand sanitizer. Bring your own bottle for personal use.



No gloves for Holy Communion.

The Precious Body cannot be distributed or received with gloved hands and will only be received by the hand. The Precious Blood is not offered at this time.



Observe social distancing.

Observe social distancing at all times, including during Holy Communion. Please stay 6 feet apart from anyone who does not belong to your household. No physical contact for greetings, the Sign of Peace, and the Our Father prayer. Singing by the congregation is discouraged at this time, due to increased respiratory output. Missalettes and prayer cards have been removed. Please feel free to bring and take home your own.



Stay home if you feel unwell.

If you are not feeling well or unsure about maintaining social distancing, please stay home, and view Mass online.
