All LRA students participate in outreach. Pre-K through 5th grade focus on local and international missions, weekly in-house projects that serve our community, and once a semester visits to the residents of local retirement centers. Students prepare songs, make cards, and actively interact with the residents.

Our MS students serve once a month by visiting local nursing homes and participating in various activities with the residents. They also volunteer their time by performing a multitude of tasks at Hill Country Daily Bread (a local food bank), Bible Study Fellowship, and Pregnancy Care Center. This gives our MS students the opportunity to serve those in need and show Christ's love through action.

LRA HS students have the opportunity to serve and be the hands and feet of local and surrounding communities 3 times a month. Through regular service, students form lasting connections with several people in the local and surrounding communities. Examples of service include mentor programs at local schools as well as schools in urban areas, students travel to the San Antonio Food Bank, as well as local area pantries to serve and help minister to those who are less fortunate.



Still others donate their time at local assisted living facilities and with local residents who need help around their home. Each ministry opportunity is unique and allows students to grow where they are planted. High school students are often stretched and learn how to depend on God during these exceptional experiences.
