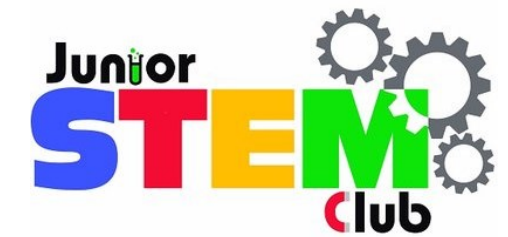
Mondays, April 8-May 13
