PENALTY AREAS RETURN – NO PLAY ZONE DISAPPEAR!

When we re-opened MountainView, we had no play zones to help the hydro sprigging take shape. Combined with the No Play and Mother Nature bringing in some moisture, we are lifting the No Play Zones effective immediately! Now, you need to play the ball where you find it or take the appropriate penalty/relief. This includes Hole #11! The wash that cuts through the fairway on #11 is now a penalty area but you can play it if you can find it.

We still can't have golf cars in these new areas...please, keep your golf car on turf and out of desert, turf reduction, and penalty areas!

NEW COURSE SLOPE AND RATINGS TAKE EFFECT TODAY!

The Arizona Golf Association (AGA) was out in mid-June to rerate MountainView now that all 18 Holes are open for play. The Course is playing slightly more difficult than the previous rating, but the change was so small that you might not see it reflected in your course handicap. As you post your scores, PLEASE enter them "Hole by Hole", as we will use that data to update our Hole Handicaps this fall when we re-order scorecards.

We are working with the Arizona Golf Association to come out in August to rerate The Preserve, so both courses will be up to date on course ratings!!

PLEASE HAVE RAKES OUTSIDE OF BUNKERS!

There is always a question about where the rakes should be on the golf course. Some believe they should be in the bunker; some believe they should be outside of the bunker. Back in 2022, the USGA officially made a recommendation on where the rakes should be. They recommend the rakes being outside of the bunker and parallel with play on the far side of the bunker! IMPORTANT DETAILS TO KNOW FOR STARTING TIMES.

Now that we have both courses back to our full 18 holes, please remember the following if you are wanting to play 9 Holes.

1. Starting times prior to 2:00pm will be considered 18 Hole Starting times.
 - a. If you are interested in playing 9 Holes in the Morning, if available, those starting times will be during the first hour of the day (700am – 800am).
2. 9 Hole Starting times can be booked via the lottery after 2:00pm or in the first hour of the day. Please indicate in the Notes of your 9 Hole desire.
3. Starting times that are open 24 Hours prior to the time you want to play, they can be booked as a 9 Hole time.
 - a. This doesn't mean you can book a time, take yourself out, and then re-book it inside of 24 Hours.
