### **A Discussion on “The Chosen” Video Series**

This is a great opportunity to discuss how the Bible comes alive in this series... and encourages us to see how Jesus continues to engage our world right now! Alan Lull will help facilitate a fun-filled, energetic conversation focusing on people, problems, and God’s amazing promises.

### **A Study of the Book of Hebrews**

In the Book of Hebrews, the Holy Spirit speaks and helps us grow to appreciate who Jesus really is and His fulfillment of the laws and promises of the Old Testament. 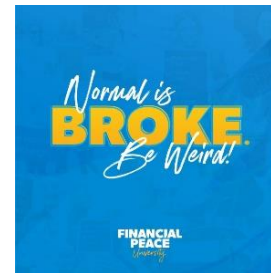
### **The Large & Small Catechisms: The Ten Commandments**
