10/9/20	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Hotels &amp; lodging for tourism:</b> fitness centers and indoor pools restricted</li> <li>• <b>Museums, zoos, &amp; aquariums:</b> indoors &lt; 25% capacity</li> <li>• <b>Personal care services:</b> indoors with modification; services requiring removal of face covering prohibited</li> <li>• <b>Libraries</b> &lt; 25% capacity</li> <li>• <b>Gyms and fitness centers:</b> indoors &lt; 10% capacity; restrictions on aerobic exercise and classes</li> <li>• <b>Outdoor film production</b> per local guidance</li> </ul>
10/13/20	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Elementary Schools:</b> may open per State and Local guidance, as ready</li> <li>• Middle and high schools may be considered in 4-12 weeks, as data trends permit</li> </ul>
For consideration in next 4-6 weeks, as data trends permit	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Indoor retail: expand to 50% capacity</li> <li>• Shopping centers: expand to 50% capacity, add food courts</li> <li>• Indoor worship services: expand to 25% capacity or &lt;100 people</li> <li>• Indoor dining &lt; 25% capacity or &lt;100 people</li> <li>• Indoor movie theaters &lt; 25% capacity or &lt;100 people</li> <li>• Outdoor cardrooms and satellite wagering</li> </ul>
