

Utilization of login.gov expands to FPDS-NG

In mid-October some of the report generation features on FPDS-NG were transferred to the Data Bank located at beta.sam.gov. “Static reports like National Interest Action reports (including the bi-weekly COVID-19 report), the annual Small Business Goaling Reports, the annual Top 100 Contractor Reports, and other periodic reports of government-wide data, remain publicly available. These can be accessed and download them from <https://beta.sam.gov/reports/awards/static>. No login is required. “If you are searching for details on specific contracts, continue using FPDS ezSearch as FPDS remains the authoritative source for entering and viewing details about contract award data.” ezSearch is a convenient, Google-like search that can be used to search for a term, contractor/vendor name, award using the PIID and a variety of other information. ezSearch also provide an advanced search tool that allows for additional filters to be used for a new search or applied to returned search results.

Currently, ezSearch is publicly accessible and there is no login required.

Starting on Saturday, December 5, users will be required to use their login.gov account to access the FPDS system. Login.gov is the system utilized by the System for Award Management and certain features of beta.sam.gov.
