## GENERAL SECRETARIAT FOR THE SYNOD OF BISHOPS


**XVI Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops**  
*“For a synodal Church: communion, participation and mission”*

The official kick off weekend across the world will be Sunday, October 17 2021. The Diocese of St Augustine event will be held at St. Joseph Parish, starting with a 2:00pm Mass, by invitation only, followed by formation and information.

### *The Three Phases of a Synod*

Every Synod primary has three phases. The first is a **preparatory phase**. Normally a preparatory document gathers information from Bishops, congregations of the consecrated, and from the Roman Curia. The second stage is the **discussion phase** wherein members, experts, auditors, and other people who have been invited attend meetings in Rome. The third phase is the **implementation phase** wherein the Holy Father, in conversation with the Bishops, create a commission or utilize a current commission to implement the work of the Synod. This is announced by way of an Apostolic Letter.

## CATHOLICS ON THE MOVE

COVID is not going to stop us from moving. We will follow all safety precautions and will keep any activity to 10 people or less in enclosed areas. We will gather in person, via zoom, or combination of both, depending on the number of people attending the events. Here are some highlights of what is coming up in the next few months:

- **ALTAR SERVERS:** We continue to recruit young children, youth and young adults to serve at our Masses. We need servers at all Masses. **Training begins this Sunday, September 12th at 1:00pm inside the Church.**
- **Adult Confirmation:** Connect with us if you are 18 or older and have received the Sacraments of Baptism and the Holy Eucharist, and are seeking to learn more about getting confirmed. Sessions are on **Thursdays, Sept 14,29; Oct 5,26; Nov 9 from 6:30pm to 8pm** via Zoom, in person or a mix. Registration is required. Call the office or sign up online on our website under “Sacraments” to get the links, etc.
- **Ask Fr. Mike:** It's back as promised! Every Wednesday at 7pm beginning on **Wednesday September 15**, inside the church. A great opportunity to ask Fr. Mike questions and have conversation.
- **Small Christian Communities** (Small Groups): Will formally begin in October, with lots of opportunities for conversation and study around topics of Scripture, Faith, life in the Church, Prayer, etc ... Sign-up opportunity coming soon.
- **A 4-Week Series by Letty Valentin:** Letty will be presenting, a 4-Week series beginning in October: **“Showing Up: Your Presence at the Eucharist”** Among other things we will discuss topics like 1) Why is our presence at the Sunday Mass required? 2) What do we do at Mass and why? 3) What do the parts of the Mass mean? Registration will be required and we will let you know as soon as registration is open.
