XVI Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops “For a synodal Church: communion, participation and mission”

The Synod of Bishops is the dynamic point of convergence that calls for mutual listening to the Holy Spirit at every level of the Church's life (cf. *Address of His Holiness, Pope Francis, Ceremony Commemorating the 50th anniversary of the institution of the Synod of Bishops*, 17 October 2015). The articulation of the different phases of the synodal process will help to make possible a true listening to the People of God to ensure the participation of all in the synodal process. It is not just an event, but also a process that involves in synergy the People of God, the College of Bishops and the Bishop of Rome, each according to their proper function. Where does the word synod come from?

The word “synod” has deep roots within the Church’s tradition. It is a two-part Greek word: *syn*, meaning “together” and *hodos* meaning the “road or the way.” Putting the two parts together, we get the meaning of walking together along the way. We see in the Scriptures, that Jesus often taught His disciples while they walked “along the way.” This idea became such a part of the community, that the followers of Jesus became known as “followers of the way.”
