EB SR 210 ON-RAMP AT SAN BERNARDINO AVENUE No Access to EB I-10 Connector

This week motorists traveling through the SR 210 project area will notice new, temporary lane configurations that affect traffic movements on SR 210, to and from I-10. Concrete barriers have been installed at key locations to safely separate travel lanes from adjacent work areas. While providing necessary protection for construction crews and the traveling public, these barriers will impact access and limit traffic movements in some places. This temporary configuration will be in place for approximately three months while crews complete the current stage of construction.

Motorists that enter EB SR 210 using the on-ramp at San Bernardino Avenue* cannot access the EB I-10 connector, and are automatically directed onto WB I-10. The following detours routes are available:

- **DETOUR 1** – From San Bernardino Avenue, travel south on Tennessee Avenue and turn left on EB I-10 on-ramp to access freeway.
- **DETOUR 2** – From San Bernardino Avenue travel south on Alabama Street and turn left on EB I-10 on-ramp to access freeway.

**Please note, motorists that enter EB SR 210 prior to San Bernardino Avenue can access either EB or WB I-10.*

For the safety of other drivers and construction crews, do not cut across work zone areas to access the EB I-10 from EB SR 210. Please use detours provided to access EB I-10.
