EB I-10 CONNECTOR TO WB SR 210 No access to SR 210 off-ramp at San Bernardino Avenue

This week motorists traveling through the SR 210 project area will notice new, temporary lane configurations that affect traffic movements on SR 210, to and from I-10. Concrete barriers have been installed at key locations to safely separate travel lanes from adjacent work areas. While providing necessary protection for construction crews and the traveling public, these barriers will impact access and limit traffic movements in some places. This temporary configuration will be in place for approximately three months while crews complete the current stage of construction.

Motorists traveling from EB I-10 connector to WB SR 210* cannot access the SR 210 off-ramp at San Bernardino Avenue. The following detour routes are available:

- **DETOUR 1** – From EB I-10 connector to WB SR 210, motorists can continue on WB SR 210 and exit 5th Street/ Greenspot Road then turn right at the end of the ramp, turn right on Boulder Avenue (becomes Orange Street) and continue south to access San Bernardino Avenue.
- **DETOUR 2** – From EB I-10, exit Alabama Street and turn left at the end of the ramp. Continue north on Alabama Street to access San Bernardino Avenue.

**Motorists traveling from WB I-10 connector to WB SR 210 can exit using the San Bernardino Avenue off-ramp.*
