
Simple Sundays

Simple Sundays? Really? If you are a Sunday school teacher, a church educator or a church pastor then Sundays are seldom “simple” for you. Congregational Ministries Publishing, a Ministry of the General Assembly Mission Council, PC(USA) has published lesson material that can make Sundays much simpler for teachers of our youth. These lessons can even be used for some adult classes.



In the Resource Center we have four new lessons in the *Simple Sundays* series:

- 1) What is a Covenant?
- 2) Who is God?
- 3) Why Did God Save Me?
- 4) How Can I Honor God in My Life?



There are six sessions per subject. Each lesson begins by giving the teacher the **Main Idea** of the lesson then a list of supplies you will need for the lesson’s activity and a **Faith Statement** taken from our denomination’s *A Brief Statement of Faith*. Teachers are then given some background information for the lesson as well as a general idea of what is to be learned and done during your time together.



Each lesson in *Simple Sundays* includes a beginning activity, an **Explore** time for bible study, and an activity as well as a closing time and more. It looks to me like the lessons will easily take 45 minutes to an hour.

If you are in charge of the education for your congregation these *Simple Sunday* lessons may make it easier for you to find teachers because the lessons require minimal preparation. While any class study benefits from some leader preparation these lessons may be done on the spur of the moment as long as the supplies are gathered before hand.
